

# Multiple Late Toll Statutory Declaration

If you have received a CityLink Late Toll invoice(s) and you were not the driver of the vehicle for any of the trips that appear on the invoice(s) you can use this form to nominate the actual driver(s). This Statutory Declaration must be completed in full and returned to CityLink by the due date of the invoice for the nomination to proceed.

Once you have completed this form in full, mail to CityLink Customer Service, Reply Paid 69935, Locked Bag 28, South Melbourne VIC 3205 or fax to 03 8656 8525. A new invoice will be issued to the nominated driver(s). If you have not nominated all trips that appear on the invoice(s) you must also pay the outstanding balance by the due date.

NB: The Melbourne City Link Act does not allow the nomination of a Late Toll invoice to a company.
